The WAND Card

The WAND Card is a discount card for 0-17 year olds with special educational needs, disabilities, or complex health needs.

The Wand Card allows concessions and discounts from participating businesses and services in Wandsworth.

(The WAND+ card is for 18-25s)

Where can it be used?

- Wandsworth Leisure Centres - swimming pool, playzone or gym use
- Battersea Arts Centre
- Battersea Park Zoo
- Clip 'n Climb
- Go Ape
- Gambado Soft Play Area

You will need to provide proof of ONE of the following:

Disability Living Allowance (DLA) or Personal Independence Payments (PIP).

Current tax credit which includes the disabled child element.

A document from a professional confirming a SEND or complex health need which impacts significantly on them getting about and accessing services/activities in the community.

London Zoo are currently offering discounted tickets for families who receive Universal Credit and families who have children with Disabilities!

If you receive Universal Credit, you can buy tickets in advance for only £3 for up to six people per household (under 3's go free and do not need to book).
